'How far does my fire engine travel on different surfaces?'

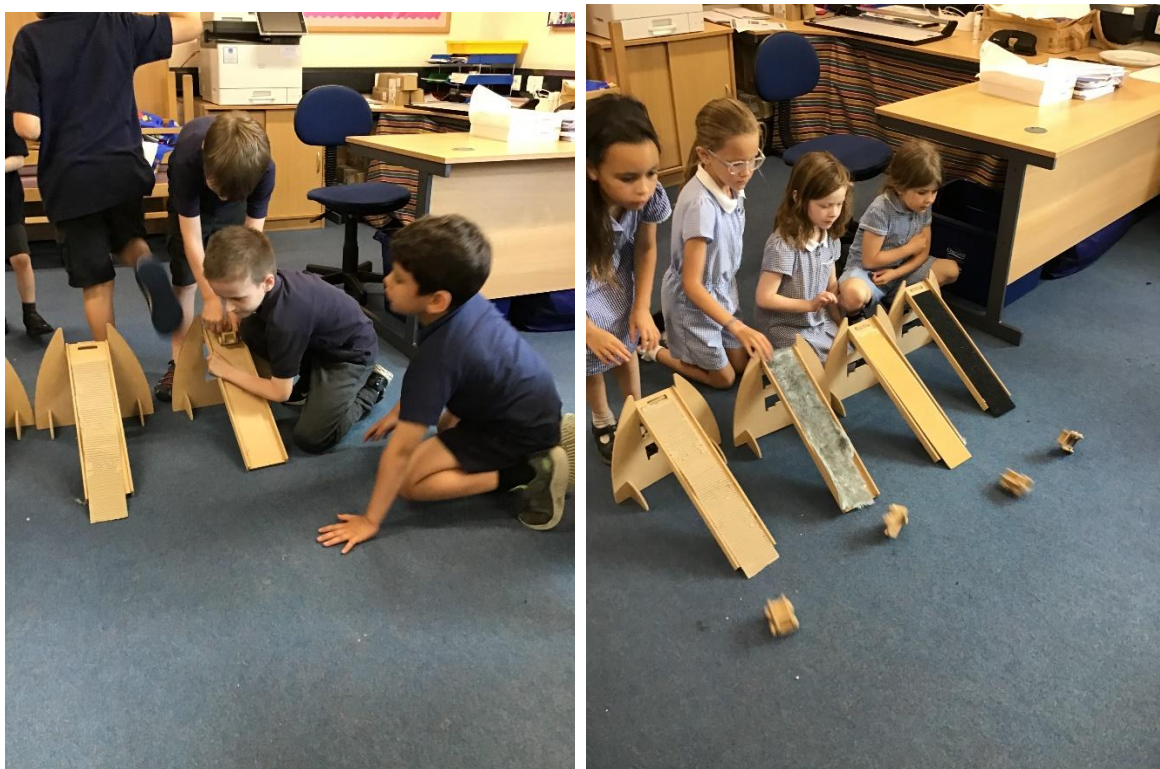
We went outside to feel different surfaces and practise using our key vocabulary.
