






Maths An amazing week in Willow for maths. We have moved on to our next station...

Ordering and comparing unit and non-unit fractions, counting beyond I and my year 4s have also been learning about mixed






numbers! We have enjoyed some split learning this week, allowing me to spend personal time with each year group!


Lesson learnt / The children soon realised that they need to use accurate language when providing instructions!
