What a busy, productive (and giggly) week!

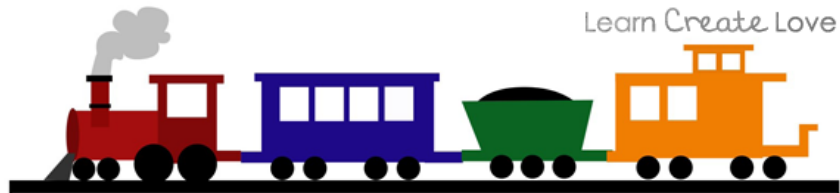

We have started our

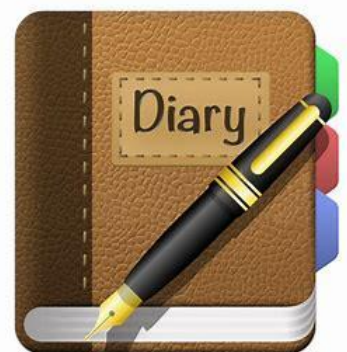
